- ✓ Create a disaster plan
- ✓ Harden your home against fire
- ✓ Register your phone number(s) at www.vcalert.org or text "VCALERT" to 313131
- ✓ Assemble an emergency supply kit
- ✓ Follow us on Twitter @VCFD_PIO or go to VCFD.org for incident info



GET SET!

As the fire approaches...

- ✓ Dress in appropriate clothing
- ✓ Ensure that you have your emergency supply kit on hand
- ✓ Stay tuned to your TV, local radio stations, social media or vcfd.org
- ✓ Pack up the car and back it in to the driveway for a fast exit

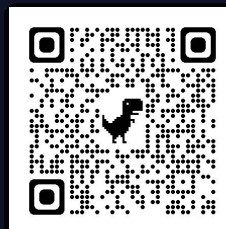


GO!

Get out early and stay out!

- ✓ Leave early enough to avoid being caught in fire, smoke or road congestion
- ✓ Go to a predetermined location out of the area
- ✓ Have several travel routes
- ✓ Take your emergency supply kit
- ✓ Leave your house unlocked
